Cognitive and Developmental Psychology Examination (weighted at 50%)

The examination will be Seen and conducted online. The questions will be provided to you on the 17th of December, and you will submit your answers on Minerva via Turnitin during the formal Assessment Period on the 20th of January (12 noon).

It will comprise two sections:

- Section A (50% of exam mark): Select ONE question to answer from a choice of two on Developmental Psychology
 <u>Topics</u>: Emotional Development, and Development of Self and Identity in Childhood and Adolescence
- Section B (50% of exam mark): Select ONE question to answer from a choice of two on Cognitive Psychology
 Topics: Long-Term Memory, and Auditory Attention

For both sections, you are expected to write a standard essay answer without a reference section (but you are expected to cite work).

There is no specific word limit, but we would recommend aiming for around 1250 words per answer.
